CALL FOR ABSTRACTS AND POSTERS

Master's and doctoral students from the three participating universities—Teachers College, Columbia University, New York; Sciences Po, Paris, and Panthéon-Sorbonne Université Paris 1—are invited to present their research-in-progress or completed research at the inter-university research conference, held on March 16, 14:00 - 18:15.

Abstracts may be submitted for either a presentation or a poster session. There will be three 75-minute panel sessions. Each panel includes three presentations (15 minutes each), followed by discussion (30 minutes total across all three presentations). The poster session (30 minutes) is scheduled during the break, between the first and second panels. Given the limited number of presentation slots (approximately three per participating university), submitted abstracts may be scheduled for a poster session rather than a presentation. Preference will be given to presentations of completed empirical studies. There will be a review committee, composed of one faculty member and one student from each of the three universities that will compose the program. The objective of the research conference is to facilitate an intellectual exchange and receive feedback from peers and faculty members at the three participating universities.
